Notes for Adjudicators:

- If a team consists of only two members, one of the team members will present a second speech. The team will therefore still present three speeches in total.
 - The person presenting two speeches must be scored on both occasions. Their highest of the two scores will be entered into our scoring system.
- Speakers may use their cell phones to time their own speeches. They cannot present speeches from their phones.
- Judges should avoid using their cell phones during a debate.
 - During the preparation time judges may step outside to use their cell phones.
 - When the debate has started, a judge may consult their phone between speeches, but only if it is necessary.
- Please intervene if a Point of Information (POI) is incorrectly handled.
 - POIs may be a maximum of 15 seconds long.
 - Ask the speaker offering the POI to sit down if they take more than 15 seconds.
 - POIs should not be offered so frequently that they become disruptive.
 - If POIs are being offered excessively, tell the team offering that they are 'badgering' their opponents and ask them to sit down.
 - When a speaker is done offering a POI they must sit down and they are not allowed to speak again, unless they offer a *new* POI.
 - Back and forth conversation between the speaker offering and receiving the POI is not permitted.
- The adjudication process should be completed speedily. Lengthy deliberations, while sometimes necessary, will cause a later than planned departure.
- Regroup in the hall after each debate.
